DAY 1: BELIZE CITY, BELIZE / AMBERGRIS CAYE

Following a light air transfer to the cayes, your adventure begins out of Ambergris, the largest island in Belize.

DAY 2: BLUE HOLE / LIGHTHOUSE REEF

Today you set sail for more remote islands, with opportunities to enjoy world class dives in these unforgettable natural habitats. The Blue Hole is a geographical phenomenon - a perfectly circular limestone sinkhole offering an array of unique stalactite formations and one of the most astounding dive sites on the planet.

DAYS 3 - 6: CAYE CAULKER / SHARK RAY ALLEY / LAUGHING BIRD CAY

These days are spent cruising in and around abundant snorkelling sites to enjoy the plentiful marine life. Drop anchor off secluded islands, and visit Caye Cauker, Shark Ray

Alley (listed as one of the best animal diving sites in the Caribbean) and Laughing Bird Cay. Onboard sea kayaks allow further exploration of the coconut-lined island gems. Dinner will be enjoyed ashore on one of the evenings.

DAY 7: PLACENCIA

Your final day sees you checking in to The Turtle Inn, a Francis Ford Coppola property, for a night of shore-side luxury after your sailing expedition.

DAY 8: PLACENCIA / BELIZE CITY

Following a last dip in the Caribbean Sea, transfer to Belize City to connect with your outbound flight.

Epic suggests diving with whale sharks (Apr – Jun) or extending your stay with explorations of the Mayan ruins in Tikal.
