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## **DAYS 1 – 2: DELHI / NAGPUR / KANHA NATIONAL PARK**

Arriving into Delhi, you connect through to Nagpur and drive to Kanha National Park (approximately 5 - 6 hours by road).

## **DAYS 3 – 5: KANHA NATIONAL PARK**

Your explorations inside the reserve will take the form of early morning and evening jeep drives and trips on elephant back. Situated in central India in the Satpura Hill ranges, Kanha Tiger Reserve offers without a doubt, India's finest tiger viewing. Spread over 1,945 sq km (750 sq miles) with a core area of just 940 sq km (363 sq miles), the grasslands and deciduous forests also support other mammals such as deer, monkey, wild boar, asiatic jackal, bison, wild dog and sloth bear.

## **DAY 6: KANHA / BANDHAVGARH NATIONAL PARK**

Today you transfer from Kanha to Bandhavgarh (approximately 6 hours by road).

## **DAYS 7 – 10: BANDHAVGARH NATIONAL PARK**

Bandhavgarh National Park covers 405 sq km (156 sq miles) and is made up of mixed forest. The core area of the park has a fragile ecology yet supports an array of wildlife, including tiger. Viewing on elephant back will again be central to the experience.

## **DAYS 11 – 12: BANDHAVGARH / JABALPUR / DELHI**

Today a 4 hour road transfer to Jabalpur connects you with your flight to Delhi where you overnight before flying home.

- This programme is **fully customisable**.
- Minimum age 8 years.
- Elephant rides depend on availability. It is therefore recommended that bookings are made as far in advance as possible.
