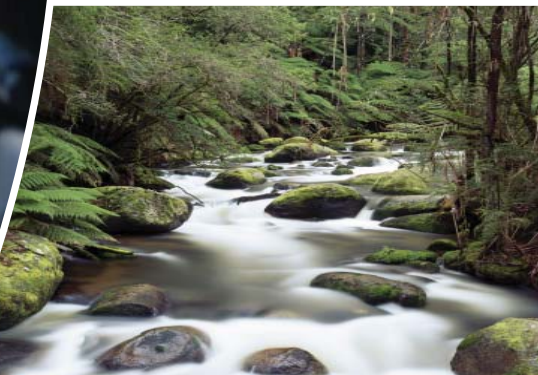

DAYS 1 – 2: LAUNCESTON, TASMANIA / STANLEY

You will be met in the historic northern city of Launceston (where your bikes have been pre-positioned) by your ride leader and support crew. Commencing with a cruise down Highway 1, you wend your way along the scenic coastal road, finishing up in the charming port of Stanley for the night.

DAY 3: STANLEY / TARRALEAH

Today you blow out the cobwebs as you head down the original 'Cobb & Co.' road. The Castle Hotel at Bothwell is a fabulous watering hole full of character and tasty Tassie food.

DAYS 4 – 5: HOBART

A great downhill cruise through the Derwent River valley brings you into Hobart, passing through the 'big tree' country of the Tarrhune Forests. Following an early ride up Mt Wellington we follow the picturesque Tasman Peninsula to the penal settlement of Port

Arthur. Options are available for adrenalin on the ocean with a rigid inflatable boat ride around the towering cliffs – anyone game?

DAY 6: SCAMANDER

The east coast is a rider's dream; great roads, sweeping corners and vistas to match. Stretch your legs at Freycinet to take in the colossal views from Cape Tourville.

DAYS 7 – 8: TAMAR VALLEY / LAUNCESTON

Today's ride is a tighter one through mountain passes and sidings that allow for a slower start to the day. You can open up along the north coast and stop for lunch on the Tamar Valley estuary at an 1850's pub before partying back in Launceston to fittingly round off the ride.
