Visit the colourful tribespeople in the highlands of Papua New Guinea and trek through pristine rainforests on the Kokoda Trail, the scene of the pivotal battle of WWII.

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DAY 1: BRISBANE, AUSTRALIA / PORT MORESBY, PAPUA NEW GUINEA

Meet in Brisbane and fly as a group to Port Moresby. Here you will overnight and undergo a thorough equipment check and briefing.

DAYS 2 – 6: KOKODA TRAIL

Trek through military history and marvel at the pristine rainforest wilderness of the rugged Owen Stanley Ranges while immersing in the untouched realms of a new frontier.

Test your mettle and fitness as you follow in the footsteps of the Australian “Diggers” who repelled the Japanese invasion in World War II. During the trek you will have a chance to pay your respects at the Shrine of Remembrance at Isurava.

At the conclusion of your trek, fly to Port Moresby and overnight.

DAYS 7 – 9: TARI VALLEY

Fly across the rugged ranges into the spectacular Tari Valley in the Central Highlands. Here you hike at a more relaxed pace to visit isolated waterfalls and local villages. Early mornings find you searching for the elusive Birds of Paradise which are the totem of the Huli Wigmen. Decorated in brightly plumed human wigs they emulate these birds in dance.

DAY 10: PORT MORESBY / BRISBANE, AUSTRALIA

Connect through Port Moresby for your flight to Brisbane.

- These months are deemed best for the trekking component of this trip. March and December are also suitable to explore the many culturally rich regions.
